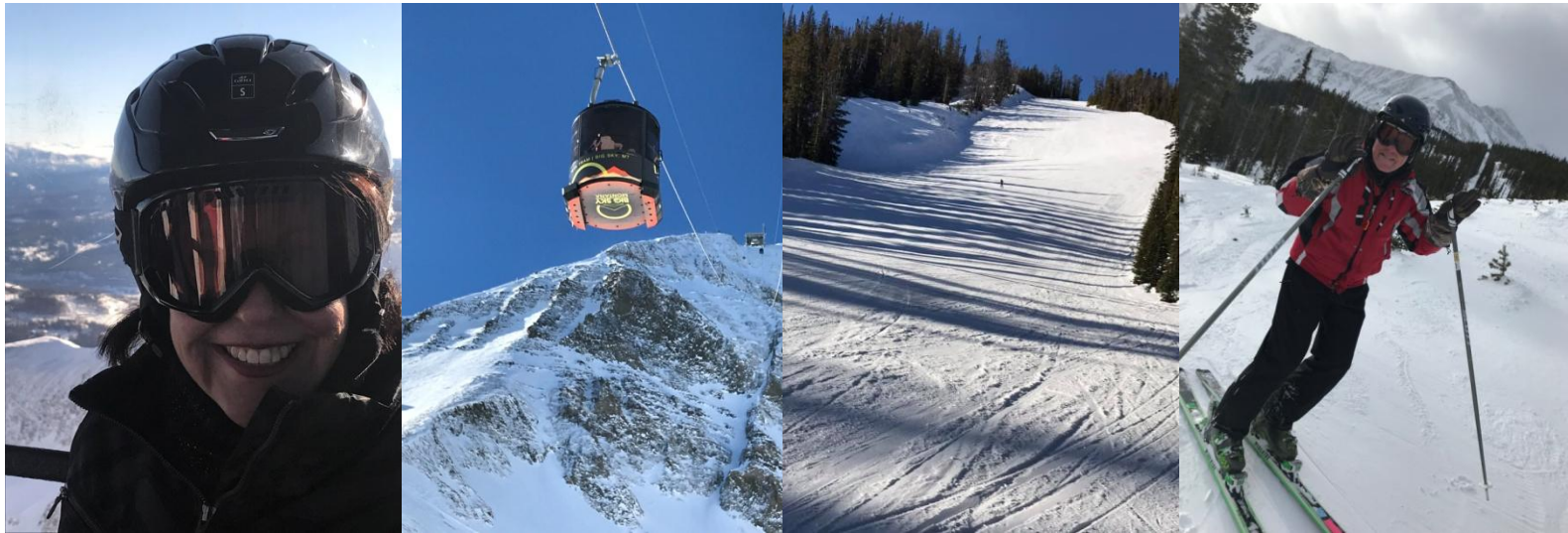
Remembering Big Sky





Thirteen brave Lone Star Skiers had a wonderful week at Big Sky Montana: Dan LeMay , Susan Williams, Rebecca Chandler, Carol Kjelstad, Wayne May, Joe Mueller, Stephen Shellberg, Jori Andrade, Carol Bonn, Randy Brazie, Fred LeVay, Andrew Kleek and Hal Preston

Big Sky lived up to its reputation with massive and diverse terrain from easy green beginner runs, to a lot of double black and experts runs: 5800 acres, 36 lifts, 4350 vertical, and many runs to choose from. In short, plenty of terrain for all level skiers. One of the very notable features of Big Sky is the incredible view from the Lone Peak viewing platform at 11,200 feet that overlooks the entire resort and capability to see the Teton Mountains on a clear day ... spectacular. One must be a very advanced or expert skier to ski down (James Mershon and Joe can give you details from personal experience), so most folks download on the gondola. Big Sky can boast about its new 8 (correct eight !!) passenger Ram Charger lift complete with heated seats and automatic bubble and foot rest features. Overall, we had good snow conditions; however, on some runs you had to be cautious of some bare ground, but not a major issue.



The Huntley Lodge is very conveniently located at the base of the new Ram Charger lift ... just grab your boots from the heated storage shelves, walk out to the ski storage and get on the lift. Also, the full breakfast buffet, omelet bar along with a selection of fresh fruit was a good start to every day. The Huntley staff were very courteous and willing to help. Being located at mountain base, it was very easy to meet up with other ski buddies; both Lone Star and other clubs. Per the suggestion of a local, we had our club dinner at Lone Peak brewery ... nice beer and food selection; very good!!

5 Lone Star Racers proceeded to take part and earn points for the club in the TSC race. The course consisted of 12 gates, set close together and we had a tight course. 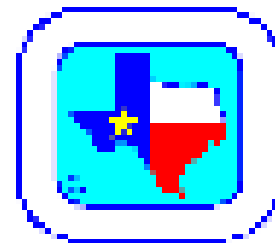
